We use knowledge organisers to provide key facts and information that children need to have a basic knowledge and understanding of a topic.

Most knowledge organisers will include:

the essential facts about the topic, usually laid out in easily digestible chunks

key vocabulary , both conceptual and technical, and their meanings

images such as maps or diagrams or time lines

famous quotations, if relevant.

We all want children to gain specific knowledge in each curriculum subject that builds up over time. Knowledge organisers play a useful role here, as they focus on one subject or topic and grow in complexity across year groups.
